On February 18, 2021, we were notified of three positive cases COVID-19 associated with students at Three Rivers High School and Hoppin Elementary, and a staff member at Three Rivers High School. In compliance with current MDHHS emergency orders public notice of this school associated case of COVID-19 is posted on our COVID-19 Dashboard located at:

Three Rivers High School and Hoppin Elementary will remain OPEN at this time. Anyone identified as a school associated close contact will be notified by Three Rivers Community Schools administrator as part of our contact tracing process. Due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individuals with COVID-19.

It is our role to tell all families of Three Rivers Community Schools that we are moving forward under the guidance of the Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency and that all measures have been taken to protect the wellbeing of your child(ren). These safety measures include required facial coverings, frequent handwashing, and sanitizing, and daily facility cleaning/disinfecting.

Please monitor for the onset of symptoms related to COVID-19; including cough, shortness of breath, fever (Temp>100.4 F), chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell. If you note any change in the health of your child, please call your regular medical provider. Thank you for your understanding and continuing support in practicing good hygiene and safety protocols relative to COVID-19. We all need to work together during these challenging times
