On October 29, 2020, we were notified of a positive case COVID-19 associated with a student at Three Rivers High School. Three Rivers High School will remain OPEN at this time. We are working closely with the Branch-Hillsdale-St.Joseph Community Health Agency to identify close contacts of the school associated cases) of COVID-19. Anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by the Community Health Agency as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. Please answer the phone if the Health Agency contacts you, as a contact tracer may be trying to reach you with important information. Due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individual with COVID-19.

It is our role to tell all families of Three Rivers Community Schools that we are moving forward under the guidance of the Branch-Hillsdale-St.Joseph Community Health Agency and that all measures have been taken to protect the wellbeing of your child(ren). These safety measures include daily health checks, required facial coverings and social distancing, frequent handwashing, and sanitizing, common touch areas and personal work space disinfecting, Daily facility cleaning/disinfecting and contact tracing with Branch-Hillsdale-St.Joseph Community Health Agency.

Please monitor for the onset of symptoms related to COVID-19; including cough, shortness of breath, fever (Temp>100.4 F), chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell. If you note any change in the health of your child, please call your regular medical provider.
