Dear TRCS Parent Guardian:

Three Rivers Community Schools continues to work closely with the Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency as it relates to limiting the spread of COVID-19 within our community. Because of the delays in contact tracing and case management process, the Health Agency has asked school districts to assist in the contact tracing of COVID-19 and in determining when a student can return to school after exposure to COVID-19.

As we prepare for students to return to school buildings, we ask that you contact your school office if your child has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 calendar days or if your child has been exposed to COVID-19 through a household member or non-household member in the last 14 calendar days. In order to provide quarantine or isolation release date, please be prepared to provide the following information:

- The date the student was exposed to COVID-19.
- A description of the exposure situation (household member or non-household member).
- Symptoms and the date symptoms started (if applicable).
- The date of the positive test result/specimen collection date (if applicable).

Thank you for your understanding and continuing support in practicing good hygiene and safety protocols relative to COVID-19. We all need to work together during these challenging times
