COVID-19 Positive Cases Reported at Three Rivers High School

Dear TRCS Parent Guardian:

On April 13, we were notified of 16 positive cases of COVID-19 associated with students or staff persons at Three Rivers High School. In compliance with current MDHHS emergency orders public notice of these school associated cases of COVID-19 are posted on our COVID-19 Dashboard located at: <https://trschoools.org/District/Portal/covid-19-dashboard>

Three Rivers High School will remain OPEN at this time. Anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by a Three Rivers Community Schools Administrator as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. Due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individual with COVID-19.

It is our role to tell all families of Three Rivers Community Schools that we are moving forward under the guidance of the Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency and that all measures have been taken to protect the wellbeing of your child(ren). These safety measures include required facial coverings, frequent handwashing, and sanitizing common touch areas and personal work space disinfecting.

Please monitor for the onset of symptoms related to COVID-19; including cough, shortness of breath, fever (Temp>100.4 F), chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell. If you note any change in the health of your child, please call your regular medical provider. Thank you for your understanding and continuing support in practicing good hygiene and safety protocols relative to COVID-19. We all need to work together during these challenging times.
