Dear TRCS Parent Guardian:

On April 28, we were notified of two (2) positive cases of COVID-19 associated with students at Three Rivers High School. In compliance with current MDHHS emergency orders public notice of these school associated cases of COVID-19 are posted on our COVID-19 Dashboard located at:

Anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by a Three Rivers High School Administrator as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. Due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individual with COVID-19.

It is our role to tell all families of Three Rivers Community Schools that we are moving forward under the guidance of the Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency and that all measures have been taken to protect the wellbeing of your child(ren). These safety measures include required facial coverings, frequent handwashing, and sanitizing common touch areas and personal work space disinfecting.

Please monitor for the onset of symptoms related to COVID-19; including cough, shortness of breath, fever (Temp>100.4 F), chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell. If you note any change in the health of your child, please call your regular medical provider. Thank you for your understanding and continuing support in practicing good hygiene and safety protocols relative to COVID-19. We all need to work together during these challenging times.
