Dear Three Rivers Community Schools Families and Staff:

Due to the recent lifting of the St. Joseph County COVID-19 Emergency Order on July 5, 2021, all future Board of Education Meetings will return to an in-person only format. We will continue to follow CDC and MiOSHA guidelines in order to keep visitors and staff safe which include continued health screening check-ins prior to entering the meeting space, social distancing of seating, and optional mask recommendations as follows:

- If you are fully vaccinated, you do not need to wear a mask indoors.
- If you are not fully vaccinated and aged 2 or older, the CDC recommends wearing a mask indoors (unless you cannot tolerate a mask due to a medical condition).

The Virtual Comment Card will no longer be used and anyone wishing to address the Board during Public Comment will need to do so in person.
